

What is Social Engineering?

It is important to use language to communicate effectively and to understand how language is used. In the simplest sense words represent more atomic concepts and when put together the atomic concepts represent more complex concepts. But to understand the complex concepts described in sentences or phrases, it is important to understand the meaning of the words inside the sentence or phrase.

To understand social engineering we take the description of each word and use that.

Social - Of or relating to human society and its modes of organization: social classes; social problems; a social issue.

Engineering - The application of scientific and mathematical principles to practical ends such as the design, manufacture, and operation of efficient and economical structures, machines, processes, and systems.

Our definition of Social Engineering is the application of scientific and mathematical principle to practical ends to design, manufacture, and operate an efficient human society.

The Strategic Social Architecture Foundation view

The principles of Strategic Social Architecture, upon which SSAF is based, state that:

Social control mechanisms will be designed, implemented, and controlled by the citizens.

and

The training of individuals who CAN run their own social order and who have characteristics which will not allow them to turn into oligarchs is in fact the sole mission of the social order.

Citizens of SSAF receive training and develop skill in Social Engineering. In this context, Social Engineering is the process of designing a social system based on Strategic Social Architecture.
